Protect yourself and your loved ones against flu



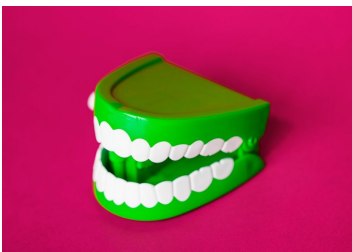
This year, the free flu vaccine will be offered to a record 30 million people to help protect as many as possible from flu and ease pressure on the NHS.

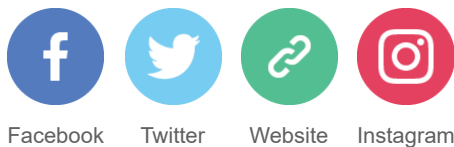
